Sioux Lookout Mobile Crisis Response Team (MCRT) offers seven-days-a-week coverage to support any community member experiencing a mental health or addictions crisis. By pairing CMHA Kenora mental health crisis workers with OPP officers, the team can respond to mental health and addictions-related police calls for service.

Sioux Lookout MCRT helps individuals in a mental health or addictions-related crisis by:

Assessing, triaging, de-escalating, and providing resources and access to mental health and addiction supports

Diverting individuals from unnecessary hospital emergency department visits and involvement with the justice system

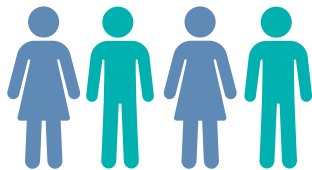
Supporting individuals experiencing a mental health or addictions crisis
